Module Content	<p>This module brings to completion the basic training in Latin grammar, syntax, and translation begun in CLU11413 Elementary Latin I. It also introduces students to a series of texts in order to develop reading and translation skills, and continues the project of engendering critical perspectives on Latin and its history. Texts covered include a variety of epigraphic, early, informal, and medieval Latin.</p>
Teaching and Learning Methods	<p>One-hour small-group language classes three times per week for eleven weeks. Attendance and completion of weekly translation homework is compulsory.</p>
