

Glossary of Terms

To help you on your way, here are a few terms you'll come across in the resources for exploring your pathway options:

A new subject you can choose to take up in your 2nd year if you are on a Single Honors (non-professional) programme

New Minor Subject

Stand-alone modules that are completely outside of your programme, worth 5 credits

Trinity Electives

Modules that are run as part of or by another programme but that are complementary and related to your own programme, worth 5 or 10 credits

Open Modules

New Minor Subjects, Open Modules, Trinity Electives and Capstone Project are all part of your degree programme Modules

The different classes that make up your course

Credits

Each Module is worth either 5 or 10 credits and you must take 60 credits in a year

Capstone Project

An independent piece of research that you carry out in your final year, worth 20 credits
