What is the role of Student Finance (SF)


- Raise the fees invoice at start of academic year for all students
- Administer sponsorships i.e. transfer fees liability from students to sponsors e.g. HEA (Higher Education Authority Free fees), SUSI supports, other public or private 3rd party sponsors
- Collect fees due from students and / or 3rd parties (government e.g. HEA / HSE or private sponsors e.g. other universities in respect of visiting students)
- Process refunds to students e.g. Erasmus or hardship payments or overpayments (e.g. where student paid in full and fees are subsequently covered by a sponsor)

Where applicable, the application fee is €55 and is non-refundable, except when the course is not proceeding, and the student is not enrolling in an alternative course. An application fee must be paid for each course route. Deposits Deposits are required to be paid by all postgraduate and non-EU undergraduate students upon accepting an offer. Your deposit payment will be deducted from your total fees. **Annual Fees** Students are liable to pay tuition fees and/or the Student Contribution fee. Registered students are also liable to pay a Student Levies and Charges (SLC) fee. Where sponsors elect to cover the SLC the full charge must be covered.

Tuition Fees (TF)

This is the core fee for your academic course, teaching, and associated facilities.

This is a registration fee that covers student services and examinations. This charge applies to EU Undergraduate degree courses only.

The SLC includes the following charges:





How to register for your course.....

How Do I Pay My Fees? - Academic Registry - Trinity College Dublin


When you receive your invitation to register:

- Log in to my tcd.ie portal and complete ALL registration tasks
- Financial task will give student a breakdown of fees owed (with description of this fee category)
- Students have the option to pay in full <u>OR</u> pay via instalments
- Liability is transferred from student to 3rd party if there is an agreement for a 3rd party to fund all or part of the fees e.g. HEA, HSE, SUSI etc
- Student can amend the *payer* details on their invoice from the student to a 3rd party if applicable



When do I pay my fees.....

How Do I Pay My Fees? - Academic Registry - Trinity College Dublin



To register, you are required to pay a minimum of:

- 50% of your tuition fees
- 50% of your student contribution fees (if applicable)
- 100% of your SLC (student levies and charges)

The remaining 50% of your fees can be paid in 2 instalments of 25% each as follows:




Registration Period	1st Instalment due – 50%	2nd Instalment due -25%	3rd Instalment due – 25%
September 2025	7th October 2025*	31st January 2026	28th February 2026
January 2026	Before last date of relevant Registration period	1st May 2026	1st June 2026
March 2026	Before last date of relevant Registration period	1st July 2026	1st August 2026

*Please note this is the last date to register. Registration should be completed as soon as possible once invited to register.






How do I pay my bill.....

How Do I Pay My Fees? - Academic Registry - Trinity College Dublin

- Domestic Students (EU & UK) pay online via <u>card</u>
 (EFT payments accepted <u>only</u> by exception)
- International Students should opt for Transfer-Mate:
 - Facilitates EFT and most international payment platforms e.g. Ali pay, AMEX etc
 - Reduced transaction charges
- Ensure your 8 digit student number is used on <u>all</u> correspondence with TCD
- Students can opt to pay in full or via instalments
- Students cannot receive exam results or graduate
 IF there is debt o/s on their account
